



Revelation ch 9: 13-21

- So far we have a demonic force that is released upon the earth.
 - They are NOT allowed to kill anyone but only torment people for 5 months
- We will notice now that in vs 15 another army, an army of 200 million lead by 4 angels is released and they can kill 1/3 of mankind.
- At this point things are getting pretty hot and the judgements are moving at a rapid pace.

The sixth trumpet

- A voice
- This voice comes from the 4 horned alter that is before God.
- This is the alter of incense.
 - From where the prayers come from.
 - So many believe that this is the Voice of Jesus sending out the order
 - He is the voice of intercession.



The River

- The river Euphrates
 - It is the eastern boarder of Isreal.
 - Eden was west of this river.
 - It separated east from west.
 - The size the armies from the “east” would be huge.
 - India 1.4 million
 - China 2 million
 - Korea(s) 3 million




Angels

- We understand that spiritual being have boundaries. (Eph 6)
- The angel, notice don't kill but send the armies.

The plagues, by these 1/3 are killed

- The smoke, fire and brimstone with power and the mouth and tails sounds like a belt fed rifle.
- When a gun fires we see fire and smoke. What is worth noting is that while the three elements are related, in the Bible they are referred to as 3 separate plagues.
- Rev. 9:18 states, “By these three plagues was a third of mankind killed-by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone, which came out of their mouths.”
- The next verse sounds like a belt fed rifle or machine gun. It reads, “For their power is in their mouth and in their tails, for their tails are like serpents, having heads; and with them they do harm

VS 20 and 21

- The rest of mankind
- Did not repent.
 - The whole point was a call to repentance.
 - They worshiped demons and idols.
 - Remember these go together!
- They did not repent of their murders (abortion (still worship!))
- drugs, sexual immorality (promotion of)
- and thefts (not just personal but through institution.)

The 10 plagues of Egypt look for patterns.

- The first water turn to blood came with a warning
- Frogs came with a warning
- The lice did not!
- The flies came with a warning
- Disease on the cattle came with a warning
- The boils no warning
- The thunder and hail came with a warning
- The locusts came with a warning
- Darkness did not
- First born came with a warning
